He talked of how the Japanese were considered to be a threat to the security of the U. S., even those that were born here and had no ties to Japan. We had a full house to hear Jim's story.

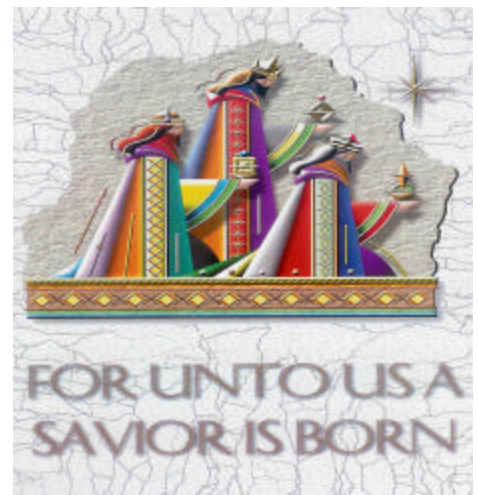

Dan Derby donated a "Shades of Blue" CD for auction. John Lundstrom had the winning bid of \$25.00.

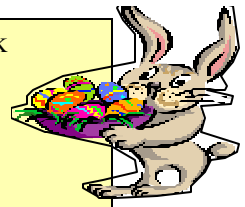
