On May 22nd. The South Hills Kiwanis will have their Pancake Breakfast fundraiser from 7:30 till Noon.



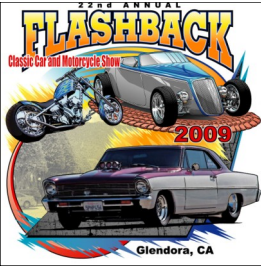
