Mark Fritz, the director of programming and development for this organization explained their programs and purpose at our meeting this week. The mission of First Tee is to impact the lives of young people by providing learning facilities and educational programs that promote character development and life enhancing values through the game of golf. This program instills nine core values into the kids. Honesty, Integrity, Sportsmanship, Respect, Confidence, Responsibility, Perseverance, Courtesy and Judgment. The home learning center for this local chapter of the International organization is Brookside Golf Course in Pasadena. They also use many other courses throughout the SGV, including Glen Oaks on Dawson in Glendora. This chapter started in 2006 with 62 kids and now serves over 5000 in core and outreach programs. The program currently is about 66 % male, and 34 % female. There are scholarships at colleges and universities for golf that go unused each year for female golfers. 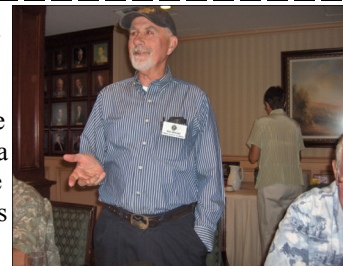
